Speakers will include officials from the New Jersey Attorney General's Office, the New Jersey State Police, the New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs, representatives from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children and victims of Internet exploitation.

The program is free, but attendees must pre-register.
