³ “Transitional reporting period” means that you have a one-year period to obtain 12 credits. At least 2 of the credits must be in ethics and/or professionalism, with the balance of credits in any other BCLE approved legal or other educational activity. No more than 6 of the 12 credits can be earned in alternative verifiable learning format courses.

⁴ “Must complete new admit requirement” means that during this 2-year reporting period you must obtain 24 credits. Of those 24 credits, 15 credits must be in 5 of the 9 New Jersey subject areas. These subject areas are: Basic Estate Administration 101; Basic Estate Planning 101; Civil Trial Preparation 101; Civil Trial Preparation 102 *or* Criminal Trial Preparation 101; Family Law Practice 101; Family Law Practice 102; Real Estate Closing Procedures 101; Real Estate Closing Procedures 102; Trust & Business Accounting 101; Landlord - Tenant Practice; Municipal Court Practice 101; and Law Office Management 101. You also must have at least 4 ethics/professionalism credits, with the balance of credits in any other Board-approved legal or other educational activity. No more than 12 of the 24 credits can be earned in alternative verifiable learning format courses.
